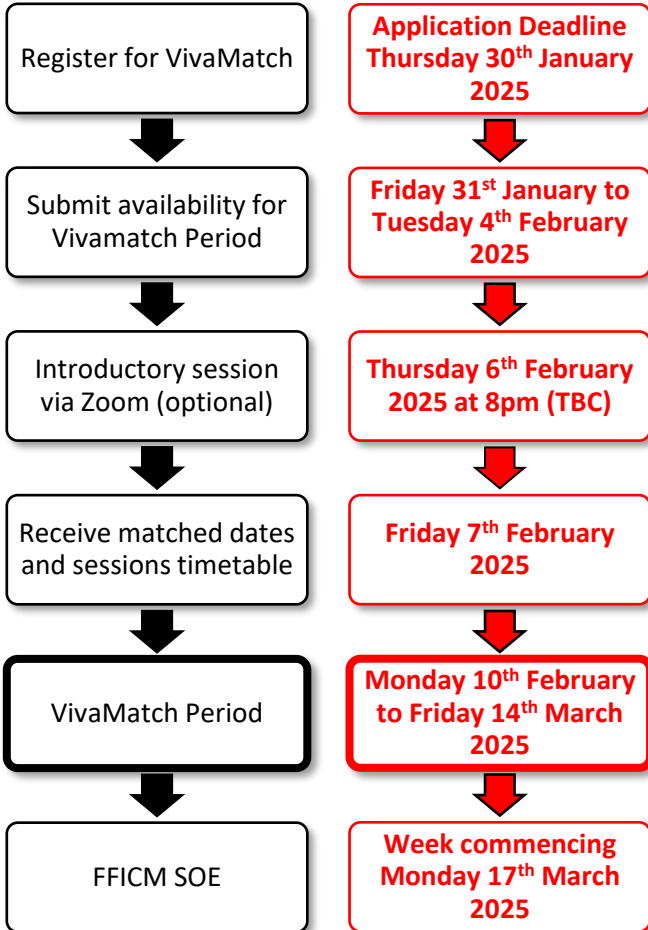

Ground Rules:

- After registration and payment, you will be sent an invitation to submit your availability for the VivaMatch Period via a Google Form.
- You **MUST** submit your availability by the submission deadline (see **Flowsheet**) – without this we will be unable to match you to other candidates.
- Session **start times** are:
 - Morning 10:30
 - Afternoon 14:30
 - Evening 19:30
- Once you receive your VivaMatch Timetable you **MUST** honour every session; **only submit availability for sessions that you know you will be available for**.
- This is a **peer-to-peer** SOE practice course. You will be matched with fellow candidates who are also preparing for the upcoming SOE.
- We **do not** provide examiners or content for you to examine each other, you will need to be prepared to ask each other questions (e.g. from text books/websites- see below).
- Work constructively with the candidate you have been matched to for that session. Be fair, considerate and constructive when providing feedback. You are in the same position with the same goals.
- **Be on time** for every session. Your matched candidate will be waiting for you.
- Keep the faith, your exam technique and confidence will improve with every session and will peak by the end of the VivaMatch Period.
- An optional **Introductory Session** will be held (see **Flowsheet**), where more information will be given, along with some tips about how to get the most out of the course, and the opportunity to ask questions.
